- (ii) Refer to paragraph 1: '... showcased 128 drawings at an auction ...' 'Over a hundred' indicates that the quantity is above 100, which aligns with the 128 drawings mentioned.
- (iii) Refer to paragraph 2: '... Lee Wai Chun Theresa, the artist-author behind the popular Miss 13-Dot series. Her '13 -Dot ' exhibition at Comix Home Base in Wan Chai ...'
